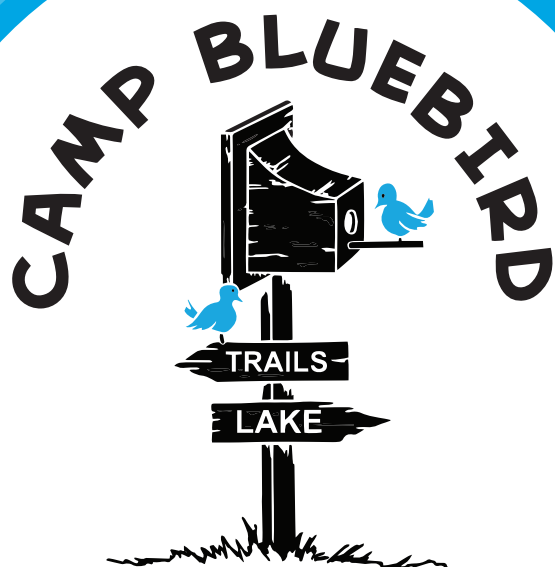




Camp for Adults with Cancer
