

Dr. Dennis Kim

Clinical Professor of Surgery, The University of British Columbia, Medical Director, Trauma Services, Vancouver Island Health Authority





Dr. Dennis Kim was born and raised in Toronto, Canada. He attended medical school at McMaster University. Following his general surgery residency, he completed his critical care

medicine fellowship at the University of Ottawa. In 2010, he moved to Southern California where he completed his fellowship in trauma & surgical critical care at UC San Diego. His passion for surgical education led him to complete a Masters in Medical Education. He spent the first 10 years of his career as a trauma attending at Harbor-UCLA Medical Center in South Los Angeles where he held several leadership positions including Co-Chair of the College of Applied Anatomy at UCLA; Vice Chair for the SoCal ACS COT and Surgical Critical Care Medical and Fellowship Director. In addition to his passion for education, Dr. Kim is an avid researcher. He has published over 150 peer-reviewed articles and several practice management guidelines, including the 2020 EAST PMG on the Evaluation and Management of Blunt Cerebrovascular Injury.

Two years ago, Dennis was recruited back to Canada where he was tasked with launching a brand new trauma program and developing the regional trauma system on Vancouver Island in British Columbia. He remains actively involved in a variety of professional organizations including the AAST and ACS Committee on Trauma.
